Featured Speakers:

- **Cst. Phil Colter:** An experienced RCMP officer with a diverse background in the Armed Forces, welding, and as a heavy-duty mechanic. Joining the RCMP in his 30s, Cst. Colter has been deeply involved with the Aldergrove Community Police Office and the Langley RCMP's Homeless Outreach Team. As a Community Liaison Officer for the Township of Langley, he will share vital updates on current crime trends and protective services.
- **Yvan Salloomi:** The current Block Watch Coordinator, bringing over 7 years of experience with the RCMP, including a previous assignment in Surrey. Yvan will discuss enhancements to the Blockwatch Program, reflecting Fort Langley's strong community spirit.
- **Captain Krista Barton:** As the Captain of Township of Langley Fire Prevention and Public Education, Krista will offer guidance on mitigating fire risks amidst ongoing drought conditions. Her role encompasses Inspections, Investigations, and Public Education.
- **Gregg Davenport:** Representing Wagner Hills, Gregg will introduce local support services available for community members, sharing his insights from over a decade of service and his personal connection to Fort Langley.
- **Cristina Schneider:** As the Residential Services Manager for Gateway of Hope and a Fort Langley resident, Cristina will outline the services available at Gateway of Hope and answer related questions.

This event marks the first Protective Services Townhall meeting since 2018, reflecting the FLCA's commitment to keeping the community informed and engaged with local services.
