Committee Report

1. Banners

**1.1. We currently have \$4,500.00 towards this year's budget.**

**1.2. Lower bar on the banners have been falling off, and the township has been contacted about dealing with this issue as it is a hazard.**

**1.2.1. Red Banners are the standard/ rotate four times a year, seasonally.**

**1.2.2. Application from the Jazz Festival to put up a banner in June.**

- 1.3. The street poles are the township's responsibility. Our responsibility are the Up and Down of the banners.

3. Fort Langley Water Supply
  - 3.1. Brent is working with Councillors directly, and many individuals directly- presentation on how water is delivered in Langley.
  - 3.2. Water Report:
    - 3.2.1. 25% of water comes from Well #2, 3 million cubic meters.
    - 3.2.2. Well #2 falls around 6.5 PH
    - 3.2.3. Fort Langley- there is no mixing of the water from the Coquitlam Shed.
    - 3.2.4. FL water is notoriously acidic.
    - 3.2.5. We were told that it is a mix 30%.70% of the mix- where you live dictates the water you get. Western-side of Walnut Grove- High PH, Fort Langley and east- Lower PH.
    - 3.2.6. If we wanted to switch to GVWD Water- it would take about a year to have that happen.
    - 3.2.7. 60% invested in equipment to boost the PH (water treatment equipment) of Well #2. Target being 7.5/8. Expectation is that this will be up and running this summer.
    - 3.2.8. We do not have to worry about our health- it is purely from an electro-chemical perspective.
